WALK BEHIND MATERIAL SPREADER WARRANTY

 All products sold by Bartell Morrison Inc. are warranted against defects in materials and/or workmanship; excluding normal wear on wearing components and components covered by a separate original manufacturers warranty, for a period of 12 months from the date of sale to the original end user purchaser provided that certain conditions have been met.

Conditions:

- 1. The equipment serial number has been registered with Bartell Morrison Inc. or its approved dealers, distributors, representatives or agents.
- 2. The equipment has been operated in an appropriate manner by qualified individuals.
- 3. The equipment has been properly maintained as per the instructions included in the Owner's Manual.
- 4. All claims for warranty must be filed on proper forms and include the serial number of the equipment along with proof of purchase.

Any evidence of failure to meet these conditions may result in a denial of the warranty claim.

- Consideration of warranty claims will be at the sole discretion of Bartell Morrison Inc., or its authorized dealers, distributors, representatives or agents.

Routine Service Intervals

Due to the nature and environment of use, the Material Spreader could be exposed to severe operating conditions. Some general maintenance guidelines will extend the useful life of your machine.

- Regular service will prolong the life of the Material Spreader and prevent expensive repairs.
- Keeping your Material Spreader clean and free from debris is the single most important regular maintenance operation, over and above the checks in the service schedule that can be performed.
- After each use your Material Spreader should be emptied and cleaned to remove any dust and debris from the hopper, gate opening, roller and surrounding components.
- Check the dust guards on both sides and ensure the chain is clean of any concrete.
- Check the gate control handle for smooth operation.
- Failure to have your Walk Behind Material Spreader regularly serviced and properly maintained in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions will lead to premature failure and void the warranty.

Using the Walk Behind Material Spreader

- Close the gate before adding any material into the hopper.
- Perform testing in order to determine a proper gate opening and proper working speed in relation to the desired quantity of material to be spread for the number of spreading passes.
- If the quantity of material has to be more than 2.5L per sq. meter, several passes will be needed.
- Walking backwards is recommended to prevent footprints.
- While spreading, lift at the handle to prevent the wheels from leaving wheel marks in the concrete.
- For best performance during spreading, keep the hopper over half full.
- Keeping your material spreader clean and free from debris is the single most important regular maintenance operation, over and above the checks in the service schedule that can be performed. After each use your spreader should be emptied and cleaned to remove any dust and debris from the hopper, gate opening, roller and surrounding components.






